Abstract

This project provides highlight for AsciiDoc source files in applications using gtksourceview-2.0 or gtksourceview-3.0.

Syntax highlight for AsciiDoc is already present for [Vim](#) and [GNU Emacs](#). But these editors are too complex and require special learning to use them. This project is for people working with more user-friendly editors, such as [gedit](#).

1 License

This project is Open-source, released under [GNU Lesser General Public License, version 2.1](#), the same license as used by [GtkSourceView](#)

2 Installation

Just copy `asciidoc.lang` file to appropriate directory:

2.1 On Linux:

The file should be copied in one of following directories (depending on which version of gtksourceview is installed):

```
/usr/share/gtksourceview-2.0/language-specs/
```

or

```
/usr/share/gtksourceview-3.0/language-specs/
```

2.2 On Windows:

If you have installed gedit for Windows in default location, the file should be copied here:

```
C:\Program Files\gedit\share\gtksourceview-2.0\language-specs\
```

3 Usage

The gedit recognises .asciidoc file extension automatically. If you are using another extension, just select appropriate highlight mode from Main Menu:

View → Highlight Mode → Markup → AsciiDoc

4 How to build this document

```
$ asciidoc -b docbook README
$ dblatex README.xml -T simple
```
